4. Display Boards

5. Youth Club

- Re YC building roof, Pride Roofing have quoted £5860 + VAT to carry out repair work only, without guarantee. It was discussed and resolved that repairs are urgently required and as a temporary measure, the immediate future of the building will be safeguarded. ACTION: Scenic to recommend to full council that this quote be accepted. AHS to prepare report.

6. Surrenden Pavilion

- MBC confirmed that project is within permitted development. JM and AHS
 liaising re documents to MBC. AHS has asked Hanson to update their quote once
 drawn plans are available.
- Discussed list of likely users, problems likely to be encountered and solutions to those problems. See attached list appendix A.
- ACTION: AHS to prepare report to full council re submission of planning permission.

7. Parade Toilets

 Clerk reports that KCC contact is proving elusive re providing a surveyor (see previous minutes.) ACTION: AHS to contact KCC Councillor Black re locating correct contact.

8. Christmas Lights/Trees

- Hawkhurst have used Hole Park to acquire small trees for the shops. However, as the trees lacked quality, they do not recommend. Further research needed.
- Kingswood trees: Re large Parade tree £120 for a 10 ft Norway Spruce or Nordman Fir. Customer can select own tree. Small trees for shops: £40 for a 4 ft and £50 for a 5ft. What do we want to do about this?
- Re storage of lights safer accommodation is still needed. After this year's display, they should be returned to Jubilee Field Pavilion.
- If we are under budget this year, should we purchase new motifs ahead of planned expenditure next year?

MA reported that she is still awaiting delivery of key for manning gate.
