 2m width and length and remain within permitted development square
 meterage. ACTION: AHS and JM will measure again to assess viability. Report to
 go to September council meeting + new Hanson quote.

- Still need to have surveyor check possible subsidence issue.

8. Xmas Lights

- Report has gone to council for next week to ask for permission to spend up to £1500 for this, as this is the amount in the budget.
